School Council Candidates

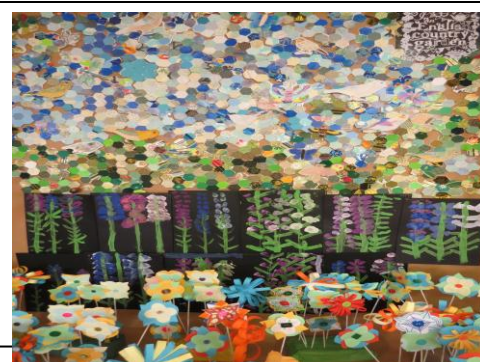
