- A complete piece/movement is expected. Songs may be reduced if appropriate (number of verses etc).
- Auditions will be judged on accuracy of performance and interpretative skill. It is expected that applicants will present work that is thoroughly prepared and demonstrates their best standards of performance. Repertoire which is of excessive difficulty may adversely affect performances.
- Those successfully passing the first round will be asked to interview/audition in front of a panel .

Gibson Fleming Trust Choral and Instrumental Scholarships

Availability of Awards

Elizabeth College offers a number of Gibson Fleming Music Scholarships. Talented and accomplished musicians are invited to apply to audition for these awards. The following awards are available in January 2025 for the current school year

Gibson Fleming Music Scholars (Years 7-9)

- Choral Scholarships
- Instrumental Scholarship

Gibson Fleming Music Scholars (Year 10-11)

- Choral Scholarship
- Instrumental/Vocal Scholarship
- Organ Scholarship

Gibson Fleming Sixth Form Music Scholars (Years 12-13)

- Choral Scholarship
- Instrumental/Vocal Scholarship
- Organ Scholarship (applicants also considered for pianists who wish to act as accompanist to College ensembles)

Duration and Value of Awards

Awards are granted on an annual basis, however, it is expected that Scholars will hold their scholarship until eligible to apply for the next level of award or until they leave College. The continued awards are subject to each musician's active involvement in the musical life of the College.

Gibson Fleming Music Scholars (all years)

The value of awards offered to Music Scholars is £105pa. There is some provision for moderate supplementary funds to be added at the discretion of the Gibson Fleming Trust on the recommendation of the panel should particular opportunities arise for scholars to further expand their musical experiences.

The role of GF Music Scholars

Each Scholar is expected to be an active participant within the Music Department, usually via participation in the extra-curricular programme. Scholars are often active in community groups and are likely to represent the College in public performances. Scholars are expected to be available to offer solo or ensemble events at particular College events annually.

Gibson Fleming Music Bursaries

Under a scheme introduced in 2019, musicians are invited to apply for means tested Gibson Fleming Music Bursaries. These will be awarded upon demonstration of suitable musical skill or potential and are designed to support students wishing to pursue musical studies that may create particular financial stress for their families. Scholars are not exempt from this scheme and may apply for a discretionary bursary to supplement their scholarship.
