

For all those not in Guernsey a quick update on the Covid-19 situation at Elizabeth College. It was fantastic to have all of our students back at College when Phase 4 began on 1 June 2020. They adapted to the new normal swiftly and took the new arrangements in their stride. Guernsey is now in Phase 5 of the 'Exit from Lockdown' framework and life is much as it was before the lockdown, with the exception of control on travel into the Bailiwick. School life has returned to normal with sports, extra-curricular activities, CCF, the Refectory and hard court all back in action.

	<b>OBJECTIVE 1 – BUILDING Purchase of Perrot Court</b>	Building purchased thanks to the generosity of our many donors. Plans are being developed and will be submitted for planning permission soon. Once converted it will hugely enhance the facilities for students at Elizabeth College.
	<b>OBJECTIVE 2 – BURSARIES Establishment of a Foundation Bursary Fund and Scheme</b>	Pledges and legacies received so far will generate a Bursary Fund sufficient to establish the Foundation Bursary Scheme and this will commence September 2021. Further fundraising will be required in the future to ensure long term sustainability.

## THE DEVELOPMENT OF PERROT COURT


The College will take vacant possession of the former Royal Bank of Canada (RBC) building in October 2020.

Plans will expand and enhance the College's facilities across a number of curriculum areas and provide spacious and flexible open plan areas. The development programme will include both a phased occupation of the new building and redevelopment and refurbishment of existing facilities to create the best possible experience for our students now and in the future.

These developments will ensure Elizabeth College has the best possible facilities suitable for a broad 21st Century education.

Once converted, Perrot Court will include:

- a **Student Hub** with enhanced **library** and study spaces, learning enrichment, **careers** and a peace room
- **Car parking** removing cars from the College forecourt which will be landscaped for student use
- an enlarged **Sixth Form Centre** including dedicated study and social areas
- **Social Sciences** faculty classrooms
- **Music** department including spaces for individuals, groups and ensembles
- **Drama** studio and flexible studio space which also provides an **exams suite**
- Relocated main College **Reception** and meeting rooms



## LAUNCH OF THE FOUNDATION BURSARY SCHEME FOR SEPT 2021 ENTRY


The Elizabeth College Foundation Bursary Scheme will be launched this September with applications open for entry into Years 7 and 12 in September 2021.

The generosity of the donations and pledges made to the Chance of a Lifetime Appeal, as well as legacies received from the Foundation's Dead Donkey Club, have ensured that the scheme is now viable.

The scheme is intended to provide an additional choice for parents whose family circumstances mean that they cannot meet the full cost of College fees. It will enable boys and girls from all walks of life in Guernsey who meet our entrance assessment requirements and who demonstrate the appropriate character and commitment to be able to attend Elizabeth College, maintaining our diversity of intake.

These means-tested awards will cover up to 100% of fees payable and applications will be welcomed for children who would benefit from our broad curriculum, outstanding enrichment activities, diverse community and inspirational environment.
